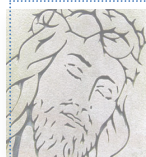

### CHURCH RESTORATION

With the summer now over, we press forward in our collective endeavour to restore our beautiful Church. Tomorrow, scaffolding will be erected inside the Church in order to clean the stonework around the windows & over the archways. This will also give us an opportunity to examine historic water damage and assess the wiring and lighting in the Church, problematic, to say the least! As you will appreciate, this is an expensive process and is only made possible by your continued support and generous donations, especially through the second collection. We are estimating this phase to cost over £20,000.
