#### HOLY SEASON OF LENT

While Ash Wednesday is not a Holy day of obligation, I would encourage you to try and attend Holy Mass.

During Lent, we especially focus on Prayer, Fasting and Almsgiving – thinking about those in need and offering financial support according to our means.

During Lent, our second collection will not go towards our building and restoration project but rather the poor & needy.

#### **FASTING & ABSTINENANCE**

Catholics, health permitting, are bound to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday from age 14 (from midnight on their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday) – this endures throughout life.

Catholics, health permitting, are bound to fast on Ash Wednesday from age 18 (from midnight on their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday) until the beginning of their 60<sup>th</sup> year (i.e. midnight on their 59<sup>th</sup> birthday). Fasting is customarily defined as one regular meal and two small snacks.
