HOLY SEASON OF LENT

While Ash Wednesday is not a Holy day of obligation, I would encourage you to try and attend Holy Mass.

During Lent, we especially focus on Prayer, Fasting and Almsgiving – thinking about those in need and offering financial support according to our means.

During Lent, our second collection will not go towards our building and restoration project but rather the poor & needy.

FASTING & ABSTINENCE

Catholics, health permitting, are bound to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday from age 14 (from midnight on their 14th birthday) – this endures throughout life.

Catholics, health permitting, are bound to fast on Ash Wednesday from age 18 (from midnight on their 18th birthday) until the beginning of their 60th year (i.e. midnight on their 59th birthday). Fasting is customarily defined as one regular meal and two small snacks.

Please report to the sacristy a minimum of **15 minuets** before Mass and tick your name on the respective rota. Failure to attend on time necessitates your ministry being reallocated.
