## Pope Benedict＇s XVI reflection on the Parish Mission

I exhort all of the faithful to make your own contribution to the building up of the community，in particular in the field of catechesis，the liturgy and charity－pillars of the Christian life－in communion with the whole Diocese．No community can live as a cell that is isolated from the diocesan context；it must rather be a living expression of the beauty of the Church that，under the bishop＇s leadership－and in the parish， under the pastor＇s leadership－walks in communion toward the Kingdom of Heaven． All must be able to find in the parish adequate paths of formation and experience that communal dimension that is a fundamental characteristic of Christian life．In this way they are encouraged to rediscover the beauty of Christ and of being part of his Church． And this is precisely also the meaning of the Parish Church：Enter here，enter into dialogue，into contact with Jesus，with the Son of God，so that we ourselves become one of those little lights that he has lit and carry light into the world that feels that it has been redeemed．（ $12 / 12 / 2010$ ）
