### EASTER MESSAGE

Archbishop John wrote to the priests of the Archdiocese in these words:

"The current lockdown had an impact on our priestly life and ministry. We feel the pain of not being able to gather with our congregations in church for the celebration of the Mass, for baptisms, weddings, and funerals. To not be "out and about" in our communities, pastorally and spiritually, is so counterintuitive to our priestly instinct. Yet, how necessarily it has been, and how essential it is, that we celebrate the Eucharist each day for, and on behalf of our people. We may be physically distanced, but we remain united in Christ." In these unusual times, when so much has changed, we wish to encourage in particular, the candidates who had been prepared for the RCIA (Rites of Christian Initiation of Adults), and every other member of our parish family, that Christ remains the same, yesterday, now and always. With our minds fixed on Him, the liturgy will carry us (and with us, within our hearts, our people) as we commemorate our Lord's saving passion, death and resurrection.

With every blessing for Easter I, your priest here extend to you all our heartfelt gratitude and assurance of unfailing prayers. May your home be blessed and sealed in the blood of Jesus. May His Sacred Heart and Immaculate Heart of Mary reign in our homes, our lives and in our world.
