Many souls appeared to St. Faustina especially those in her own Congregation asking for prayers. St. Faustina prayed for a sister who had died and who appeared to her in a terrible condition. She redoubled her prayers and next saw the sister in an even more horrible state. St. Faustina asked her, "Haven't my prayers helped you?" The sister answered that nothing would help her, but the prayers helped other souls. St. Faustina told the sister if her prayers were not helping then please stop coming to her. The sister disappeared at once, but St. Faustina continued to pray for her. Eventually the sister appeared again and was more radiant and beaming with joy. She urged St. Faustina to never cease praying for the souls in purgatory and added that she herself would not remain there much longer (58). The souls also told St. Faustina what they need us to do – offer Mass, fast, pray the Rosary, recite the Eternal Rest prayer.
