In addition, you

might consider attending the Chrism Mass at St George’s Cathedral at 11.00am on Wednesday 27th March during which the priests throughout the diocese renew their priestly promises and the Archbishop blesses the Holy Oils for the year ahead. The Chrism Mass is always a very uplifting and inspirational experience.
