THE ROSARY IN OCTOBER

With October being the month of the Rosary, The Church grants daily a plenary indulgence to those who say the rosary either in Church or in their family or as a group. A partial indulgence is granted daily by reciting the Litany of Loreto and the prayer to St. Joseph.

THE HAIL HOLY QUEEN

This is the ancient prayer to Our Lady dating back to the 12th century. Traditionally it is recited at the end of the Rosary; it is sung as an anthem in Latin, *Salve Regina*, on special occasions. It is important that our young people learn these ancient customs, so, during October, we will recite the prayer at the end of the bidding prayers and sing the Marian Anthem at the end of Mass, before the final hymn.
