OUR LADY'S STATUE

The statue of Our Lady has now gone off for restoration. It is a beautiful statue and much loved by us all. It should be back before Christmas then we will start restoring: The Sacred Heart, St. Anthony, St. Thérèse of Lisieux, and the magnificent crucifix in the confessional. The cost of restoring Our Lady's Statue is the most expensive at £4,440. This includes replacing the missing finger, re-pinning to prevent further cracking, re-gilding and painting. It is a lot of money, but you cannot buy this level of quality anymore. It is certainly older than the Church, probably mid 1800's. If you would like to donate towards Our Lady's restoration, in thanksgiving or in memory of a loved one please see a member of the clergy.

NOVEMBER MONTH OF THE HOLY SOULS

November, which is fast approaching, is the month when we particularly pray for the Holy Souls in purgatory – our relatives and friends and those who have no one to pray for them. Purgatory is a state of purification before souls enter into heaven. At the back of the Church, and in your benches, you will find brown Holy Souls envelopes into which you can place the names of those you wish to remember (Catholic or non-Catholic). Those names will be placed under the altar and remembered at every Mass during November. The custom has always been to place an offering in the envelope. The offerings are collected together and for every £10 a Mass is offered for the Holy Souls throughout the year.

HOLY COMMUNION

Holy Communion is now administered along the altar rails. You have the option of either kneeling or standing and to receive either on the tongue or in the hand. Remember, if you receive on the hand, place the host immediately into your mouth, do not walk away with the host in your hand. Those who have yet to make their First Holy Communion, and non-Catholics, are welcome to receive a blessing, please indicate this by crossing your hands over your chest.
