#### SACRISTY

Work has begun on the lower sacristy, which is now out of bounds. Please be careful when entering the Priest's sacristy and when walking towards the toilet.

The lower sacristy has suffered from water penetration, from both the roof and rising damp, for a number of years. The plaster, which has blown, will be removed to enable a damp course and insulation to be added. Once the new roof has been fitted. and the room rewired, a new floor will be built bringing the level up to that of the Church and the sacristy. This will allow easier access for the alternatively abled, the mature in years, and parents with buggies and children. I do not anticipate that the room will be finished before the New Year. Once it is completed, we then begin work on the priest's sacristy. Photos are available on the web.
