

### PLEASE SUPPORT OUR BUILDING & RESTORATION PROJECT

All of the money raised in the second collection goes towards the restoration of our beautiful Church.

The beautiful stonework around the upper windows is slowly being restored. A seal is being applied around the windows to prevent future water penetration. Plaster, which has blown, is being removed; a water sealant will be applied before re-plastering.

On 23 October we will begin to rewire the Church and fit new lights (£20,000), with proper circuit breakers. This will be a somewhat lengthy process as the electrician has other commitments. Much of the wiring is incredibly old with areas having not been earthed.
